The Parish is showing a surplus of $\notin 26,637$ for 2015 compared with a surplus of $\notin 7,629$ for 2014 with the gross income up 5.8% to $\notin 346,421$ (2014 $\notin 327,571$), thanks to the generosity of our Parishioners, in particular, those who contribute by way of the weekly offertory envelopes.

The spend on maintenance, repairs and decoration of €32,104 is after credits of €24,585 for insurance claims.

The collections for the support of Priests (active and retired) go directly to the Common Fund. Our Parish reached its target of €165,700 for 2015, once again reflecting the generous response of Parishioners throughout the year and, in particular, to our special appeal before Christmas. We also had targets for the other collections (Diocesan Needs Appeal, Education of Priests, Peter's Pence and Propagation of the Faith) on which there was a net shortfall of €26,274 (2014 €22,117). All collection shortfalls must be funded out of Parish income.

Funds raised under the Parish Development Plan (Building Fund) are accounted for separately and periodically reported (monthly) in our Parish newsletter.

We thank sincerely all Parishioners, particularly in these difficult times, for their generous support in so many ways during the past year.
