It is only by taking full account of all the detail arising that a plan can then be drawn up to chart a pastoral map into the future, addressing the many challenges that we face, and embracing the invaluable opportunities that are implied.

Today we choose to highlight topic No.10, <u>Lay Involvement</u>. We quote: "Lay people need to be more involved in meaningful ways," and, "With older priests and falling numbers more lay people will have to be trained for parish duty."
