Please note the 9.00 a.m. Mass, has been moved from Bóthar na Naomh Church to the Cathedral (capacity 150) and the Bóthar na Naomh Sunday Mass (capacity 70) will now take place at 10.00 a.m. This change is due to the increased numbers in attendance at our Sundau mornina Masses

CATHEDRAL: MONDAY - SATURDAY: 11.00 A.M.

EVENING MASS: MONDAY, WEDNESDAY & FRIDAY: 7.00 P.M.

BÓTHAR NA NAOMH CHURCH EVENING MASS: TUESDAY & THURSDAY: 7.00 P.M. We ask everyone to consider attending a maximum of one Mass per week to dispel the possibility of larger crowds attending any given Mass. We would like to remind people to sit on the X, as these are clearly marked for social distancing. The Cathedral is open for private prayer after 11.00 a.m. Mass until 5.00 p.m. each day. Bóthar na Naomh Church is open for private prayer from 9.00 a.m. - 2.00 p.m. each day except on Sundays when it will remain open after 10.00 a.m. Mass until 2.00 p.m. Pallottine College Chapel is open for Mass at 10.00 a.m. each day. The capacity for Pallottine College Chapel is 36 people.

- Funerals: Maximum of 50 people allowed at Funeral Masses, regardless of the size of the church – hence 50 only in our Cathedral. (i.e. regular daily Masses 150 people allowed, Funeral Masses 50 people allowed). We appeal to our parishioners that if it was your intention to attend the 11.am Mass, in the event of a Funeral taking place please make an effort to attend the evening Mass on that day instead. People not attending the Funeral Mass are asked to avoid congregating immediately outside the church building or around the hearse. For the sake of the great majority trying to keep to the public health guidelines, we ask people, difficult as it is, not to approach the bereaved in the church grounds or cemetery to sympathize.
- **Baptisms:** No bookings for Baptisms can be taken until further notice.
- Weddings: Up to 50 guests are permitted to attend a wedding ceremony.
- **Confessions** will not take place until further notice.
- Cemetery Masses: In the present circumstances Cemetery Masses cannot be held until later in the summer, when circumstances, hopefully, will permit them to be truly family and community celebrations in a safe environment.
- Wearing Of Face Coverings is compulsory when visiting the Cathedral or Bóthar na Naomh Church. (It is understood that for medical reasons some people may not be able to comply with this regulation.)

HOLY WATER: If you need Holy Water please bring your container, filled with water to the Parish Centre for blessing.
