Our Raise the Roof Lotto was introduced in June 2021 to help create a fund for the replacement of the roof of our Cathedral. We are very grateful for all the support received for this project which has netted €135.913.00 from June 2021 to July 2023. We are now offering a cash payment facility to join the Lotto, a request that many of you have previously made. As Banking online is not suitable for some of our parishioners, we feel this is a very suitable alternative. If you are interested in availing of this method of payment to ioin our Lotto, please call into the Parish Office where Maire, Louise and Cathy can set up this cash payment for you. In adherence with the Lotto Company Regulations Cash Payments can only be made through the Parish Office, for a minimum of 20 weeks, or alternatively 40 weeks and/or maximum of 52 weeks. When joining you can decide one line @ €2 per week or 3 lines at €5 per week. The Lotto numbers you choose will hold for the duration of the payment. The office staff will complete your Lotto Membership Form which will outline the amount of your payment, your Lotto numbers and the beginning and end date of your Lotto Membership. Up to last Friday we had 500 members in our Lotto which is raising a substantial amount of money for the Reroofing Project. Following last weekend's appeal 26 new people have joined the Lotto. We are thrilled with this response and if we could continue to increase our numbers, it would help create a considerably larger fund enabling us to begin and complete the work on the Cathedral Roof. Unfortunately, work cannot commence until we have 1 million in the Building Fund Account. At present we have €530,674.00 - all raised through your continued assistance, commitment, generosity and support.
