As we approach its 150th anniversary in 2029, we are reminded that this remarkable building has stood with us for generations. But time has taken its toll.

To date, our fundraising efforts have already seen great generosity from parishioners, community members, and friends near and far - and we are incredibly grateful for every single contribution received so far. But we are at a crucial juncture. The time to act is now.
