Gross income increased by about 13% during 2024 to €428,651 (2023 €379,338). The 2024 increase follows a similar increase during 2023. Despite these recent years' increases in gross income, the Parish is not yet fully back to where it stood in the pre-Covid year of 2019.

Costs were down by €12,149 for energy and by €2,953 for phone, postage & stationery.

The net spend on maintenance, repairs, decoration between ongoing and non-recurring expenditure for 2024 was €55,140 (2023 €70,899), a reduction of €15,759.

The Parish made a surplus in 2024 of €63,529 compared with a shortfall in 2023 of -€21,832. This has come about through the combination of increased income and cost reductions referred to above.

The Collections for the support of Priests (active and retired) go directly into the Common Fund, this is a separate account funded solely by the Clergy Collections. Our Parish well reached its target for 2024 of €127,166 (2023 target €127,166) reflecting the continued generous support of Parishioners. Surplus to target on the Common Fund may be used for parish needs.

We had a target of €50,095 for the 2024 Diocesan Services collection, the target in 2023 was €38,535. The Diocesan Services collection in 2024 amounted to only €4,540 (2023 €6,075) leaving very significant shortfalls which were made up from the Common Fund.

Funds raised for Parish Building Projects are accounted for separately and periodically reported.

We thank sincerely all Parishioners for their generous support in so many ways during the past year.
