The Parish is showing a surplus of €7,629 for 2014 compared with a shortfall of €5,190 for 2013. General income was up 5% at €327,571 (2013 €309,654).

The spend on maintenance, repairs and decoration of  $\in 23,588$  is after a credit of  $\in 22,514$  for an insurance claim to cover spending of  $\in 22,814$  following storm damage to the Cathedral.

The collections for the support of Priests (active and retired) go directly to the Common Fund. Our Parish reached its target of  $\in$ 177,261 for 2014, reflecting the generous response of Parishioners to our special appeal before Christmas. There was a small shortfall in 2013 on the Common Fund of  $\in$ 6,415. We also had targets for the other collections (Diocesan Needs Appeal, Education of Priests, Peter's Pence and Propagation of the Faith) on which there was a net shortfall of  $\in$ 22,117 (2013  $\in$ 23,453). All collection shortfalls must be funded out of Parish income.

Funds raised under the Parish Development Plan (Building Fund) are accounted for separately and periodically reported (monthly) in our Parish newsletter.

We thank sincerely all Parishioners, particularly in these difficult times, for their generous support in so many ways during the past year.
