The Parish is showing a surplus of  $\notin$  31,146 for 2017 compared with a surplus of  $\notin$  64,765 for 2016 with gross income down slightly to  $\notin$  365,254 (2016  $\notin$  369,292).

The net spend on maintenance, repairs and decoration of  $\notin$ 48,912 is up on the 2016 figure of  $\notin$ 32,010. The increase is mainly attributable to Parish Centre repairs, decoration and Cathedral lighting.

The collections for the support of Priests (active and retired) go directly to the Common Fund. Our Parish reached its target of €154,140 for 2017, (2016 target was €161,847) reflecting the generous response of Parishioners, to our appeal before Christmas.

We also had targets for the other collections (Diocesan Needs Appeal, Education of Priests, Peter's Pence and Missions) on which there was a net shortfall of  $\notin$ 23,403 (2016  $\notin$ 21,522). All collection shortfalls must be funded out of Parish income.

Funds raised under the Parish Development Plan (Building Fund) are accounted for separately and periodically reported in our Parish newsletter.

We thank sincerely all Parishioners for their generous support in so many ways during the past year.
