## THURLES PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL

Having received instruction from the Irish Bishops conference and discussed it at length – in order to safeguard our parishioners and the society at large and wishing to comply with the demands of the instruction, the following regulations have been implemented:

WEEKEND MASSES & WEEKDAY MASSES ARE cancelled (Please note: our Bishops have dispensed the obligation to attend Sunday Mass during this time). **CONFESSIONS:** The normal schedule of Confessions in our churches has ceased

for the time being.

**BAPTISMS & WEDDINGS:** Will not be celebrated until further notice.

**VISITING OF THE SICK & FIRST FRIDAY CALLS**: Based on public health guidelines, First Friday house visits and other pastoral house visits have ceased except in the case of emergency.

**FUNERALS:** Due to the number of people now permitted to gather, numbers for funerals must be kept to an absolute minimum.

Mass without a congregation will be offered by our priests for the good of all our parishioners.
